SKY Perfect JSAT Corporation (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; President and CEO: Masanori Akiyama) has determined the launch schedule for its JCSAT-12 communications satellite. Details are as follows.

The JCSAT-12 communications satellite will be launched as the successor craft (JCSAT-RA*1) to JCSAT-R, which is currently in geostationary orbit as a backup satellite. Through JCSAT-12, SKY Perfect JSAT will ensure the stability of its satellite fleet and provide highly reliable satellite communications services.

*1 Once JCSAT-12 becomes operational, it will be referred to as JCSAT-RA.

2. Launch site: Guiana Space Centre, French Guiana

3. Launch vehicle: Ariane5 (Arianespace)

4. Satellite bus: A2100AX (Lockheed Martin Corporation)

5. Satellite specifications:

(1)Frequencies K_u band and C band

(2)Transponders 30 K_u-band transponders and 12 C-band transponders

(3) Coverage area: Japan, Oceania, Asia-Pacific region, Hawaii

(4)Design Lifetime: 15 years

6. Planned orbital slot: In-orbit backup satellite
