## JSAT to Exhibit at CommunicAsia2007, Asia's Largest Info-Communications Conference

To increase presence and strategic development in Asia

JSAT Corporation (Head Office: Chiyoda-ku, Tokyo; President and CEO: Kiyoshi Isozaki; "JSAT") will run a booth at CommunicAsia2007, Asia's largest international communications and information technology exhibition and conference. CommunicAsia2007 is being held at Singapore Expo in Singapore from June 19 (Tue) to 22 (Fri).

Since its establishment in 1985 as Japan's first private-sector satellite communications company, JSAT has provided a new communications network, pioneering the satellite communications market. JSAT has kept the provision of services overseas in mind from the outset, using JCSAT-3 (launched 1995) and JCSAT-1B (launched 1997) to begin international satellite communication services to Asia and Hawaii. Recently, we have been expanding our service area beyond Asia to include North America, with the Horizons Project—Horizons-1 was launched in 2003 and Horizons-2 is scheduled for launch in the fall of 2007. JSAT has also purchased some of the transponders on Intelsat 15 (IS-15), which is owned by Intelsat, the world's largest satellite operator, and scheduled to enter service in 2009. JSAT is focusing on fostering new demand in Asia for satellite communication services and will use these transponders to extend services to the region around the Indian Ocean.

Meanwhile, the Hong Kong Office, which was established in October 2002, was upgraded to branch status in January this year and is focusing on sales activities to expand use of satellites, as JSAT works to expand its presence and develop its strategic base in Asia.

JSAT's goal in exhibiting at CommunicAsia2007 is to deepen people's understanding of measures it is taking to provide satellite communications services to Asia, a region showing remarkable economic growth, and of its

satellite network. JSAT's booth (No. 6L2-1) measures approximately 36m<sup>2</sup> and will include panel exhibitions of JCSAT-5A, JCSAT-3A, and JCSAT-2A, satellite providing services to Asia. It is hoped that the move will help to increase JSAT's client base.




Image of JSAT's booth at CommunicAsia2007
